A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF GREENVILLE TO COLLECT AN AUTO TAX FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS AND INFRASTRUCTURE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS UPON THE EXPIRATION OF THE GLOBAL TRANSPARK VEHICLE TAX LEVY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. In addition to any vehicle tax which the City of Greenville may levy pursuant to G.S. 20-97, the City of Greenville may levy an annual registration tax of five dollars (\$5.00) on any vehicle resident in the city with the proceeds of this tax being used only for economic development projects and infrastructure construction projects.

Section 2. This act applies to the City of Greenville only.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and the tax authorized in Section 1 of this act may only be collected upon the repeal of the tax levied upon vehicles resident in the City of Greenville pursuant to G.S. 158-42.
