A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COMMUNITY MEDIATION CENTERS ACROSS THE STATE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative 6 Office of the Courts the sum of six hundred ninety-seven thousand nine hundred three 7 dollars (\$697,903) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of six hundred ninety-seven 8 thousand nine hundred three dollars (\$697,903) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for 9 additional funding for 25 community mediation centers, also known as dispute settlement 10 centers, across the State and for new funding for the Mediation Network of North 11 Carolina.

Section 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year shall be allocated for new funding for the Mediation Network of North Carolina. The remaining funds shall be allocated for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and for the 2000-2001 fiscal year as follows:
