A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE AND APPLY RETROACTIVELY THE EXEMPTION FROM  
2 LICENSURE FOR CERTAIN ADULT CARE HOMES MAINTAINED OR  
3 OPERATED BY A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 131D-2(c) reads as rewritten:

7 "(c) The following are excluded from the provisions of this section and are not  
8 required to be registered or obtain licensure under this section:

9 (1) Facilities licensed under Chapter 122C or Chapter 131E of the General  
10 Statutes;

11 (2) Persons subject to rules of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation  
12 Services;

13 (3) Facilities that care for no more than four persons, all of whom are under  
14 the supervision of the United States Veterans Administration; ~~and~~

15 (4) Facilities that make no charges for housing, amenities, or personal care  
16 service, either directly or ~~indirectly~~-indirectly; and

17 (5) Institutions that are maintained or operated by a unit of government and  
18 that were established, maintained, or operated by a unit of government  
19 and exempt from licensure by the Department on September 30, 1995."

20 Section 2. This act is effective on and after September 30, 1995.
