A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO BAN NEW OR REPLACEMENT BILLBOARDS ON A PORTION OF
2 U.S. HIGHWAY 52 AND NORTH CAROLINA HIGHWAY 752 IN SURRY
3 COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 559 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as
7 rewritten:

8 "Section 1. No new or replacement outdoor advertising, as defined in G.S. 136-
9 128(3), that is visible and intended to be read from the right-of-way of the portion of
10 North Carolina Highway 752 and United States Highway 52 south of the airport forming
11 a corridor through the foothills of Surry County past Pilot Mountain State Park, shall be
12 erected on or after the effective date of this act. No new or replacement outdoor
13 advertising, as defined in G.S. 136-128(3), shall be erected within 660 feet of any
14 interstate highway located in Buncombe County outside the corporate limits of a
15 municipality."

16 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
