10	This Article applies to members of the State Board of Elections and of each county
11	and municipal board of elections. With regard to prohibitions in this Article concerning
12	candidates, referenda, and committees, the prohibitions do not apply if the candidate or
13	referendum will not be on the ballot in an area within the jurisdiction of the board, or if
14	the political committee or referendum committee is not involved with an election or
15	referendum that will be on the ballot in an area within the jurisdiction of the board.
