Referred to: Appropriations/Base Budget. May 23, 2000 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED APPROPRIATE FUNDS ANACT TO TO CLOSE THE **ACADEMIC** ACHIEVEMENT GAP THAT EXISTS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of forty million nine hundred sixty-six thousand four hundred dollars (\$40,966,400) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. Of these funds: The sum of thirty-one million three hundred eighty-six thousand eight (1) hundred dollars (\$31,386,800) shall be used for activities and programs to close the academic achievement gap that exists between minority and at-risk students and other students in the public schools; and The sum of nine million five hundred seventy-nine thousand six (2) hundred dollars (\$9,579,600) shall be used to address the needs of students with limited english proficiency. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
