4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 7A-65(d) reads as rewritten:
6	"(d) In lieu of merit and other increment raises paid to regular State employees, an
7	assistant district attorney shall receive as longevity pay an amount equal to four and
8	eight-tenths percent (4.8%) of the annual salary set forth in the Current Operations
9	Appropriations Act payable monthly after five years of service, nine and six-tenths
10	percent (9.6%) after 10 years of service, and fourteen and four-tenths percent (14.4%)
11	after 15 years of service. service, and nineteen and two-tenths percent (19.2%) after 20
12	years of service. "Service" means service as an assistant district attorney or as a district
13	attorney."
14	Section 2. G.S. 7A-467(d) reads as rewritten:
15	"(d) In lieu of merit and other increment raises paid to regular State employees, an
16	assistant public defender shall receive as longevity pay an amount equal to four and
17	eight-tenths percent (4.8%) of the annual salary set forth in the Current Operations
18	Appropriations Act payable monthly after five years of service, nine and six-tenths

19 percent (9.6%) after 10 years of service, and fourteen and four-tenths percent (14.4%)

- 3 Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 4 Department the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal 5 year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal
- 5 year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2000-2001 fisca 6 year to provide the additional longevity established in this act.
- 7 Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
