March 3, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PERMITTED SUPERVISING DRIVERS UNDER THE GRADUATED DRIVERS LICENSE PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 20-11(k) reads as rewritten: Supervising Driver. – A supervising driver must shall be a parent or guardian of "(k) the permit holder or license holder or a responsible person approved by the parent or guardian or the Division. A supervising driver must shall be a licensed driver who has been licensed to drive for at least five years. A supervising driver must shall sign the application for a permit or license. Each permit or license issued pursuant to this section shall be limited to a maximum of two-three supervising drivers." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
