March 15, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR VARIOUS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of eight million five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$8,550,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of eight million five hundred thousand dollars (\$8,500,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be allocated as follows: \$2,000,000 to North Carolina Institute of Minority Economic (1) Development, Inc., to establish new centers to foster minority economic development within the State. \$550,000 to North Carolina Association of Community Development (2) Corporations, Inc., to provide training, technical assistance, resource development. and support for local community development corporations statewide. \$2,000,000 to the Center for Community Self-Help to further its (3) statewide program of lending for home ownership throughout North
