A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SIT-IN MOVEMENT, INC., FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL
RIGHTS CENTER AND MUSEUM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Sit-In Movement, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year for the construction and renovation of the International Civil Rights Center and Museum in the City of Greensboro.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
