1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT ALLOWING COUNTIES HAVING A POPULATION IN EXCESS OF
3	500,000 TO PROVIDE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR PERSONS OF LOW AND
4	MODERATE INCOME.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The General Assembly finds and declares that the purpose of this
7	act is to provide authority for larger urban counties in North Carolina to provide funds for
8	residential housing construction, new or rehabilitated, and to provide for the sale or rental
9	of housing to persons and families of low and moderate income. The General Assembly
10	finds and declares that there exists in larger urban counties, including rural areas of such
11	counties, a serious shortage of decent, safe, and sanitary residential housing available at
12	low prices or rentals to persons and families of low and moderate income. This shortage
13	is inimical to the health, safety, welfare, and prosperity of all residents of the State and to
14	the sound growth of North Carolina communities.
15	Section 2. Part 5 of Article 18 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is
16	amended by adding a new section to read:
17	" <u>§ 153A-378. Low- and moderate-income housing programs.</u>
18	In addition to the powers granted by G.S. 153A-376 and G.S. 153A-377, any county
19	is authorized to exercise the following powers:
