Section 1.(a) Effective July 1, 1999, the State shall pay sixty percent (60%) and the county shall pay forty percent (40%) of the nonfederal costs of Medicaid services paid to adult care home facilities.

Section 1.(b) Effective July 1, 2000, the State shall pay seventy percent (70%) and the county shall pay thirty percent (30%) of the nonfederal costs of Medicaid services paid to adult care home facilities.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of thirteen million two hundred forty-two thousand six hundred forty-four dollars (\$13,242,644) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-nine million two hundred seventy-five thousand five hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$29,275,569) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the State share of nonfederal costs of Medicaid services for State County Special Assistance for Adults.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
