**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ERECTION OF OUTDOOR ADVERTISING ON A  
PORTION OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 40.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. No outdoor advertising, as defined in G.S. 136-128(3), that is visible and intended to be read from the right-of-way of the portion of Interstate Highway 40 from the Orange-Alamance county line to the municipal limits of the City of Wilmington shall be erected on or after the effective date of this act.

Section 2. Section 1 of this act shall not apply to outdoor advertising described in G.S. 136-129(1), (2), or (3).

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
