A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO IMPROVE THE UNIVERSAL 2 3 CHILDHOOD VACCINE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of seven million seven hundred thirty-five thousand 6 three hundred twenty dollars (\$7,735,320) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of 7 seven million seven hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred twenty dollars 8 (\$7,735,320) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the Universal Childhood Vaccine 9 Distribution Program. These funds shall be allocated as follows: 10 \$2,427,320 for Hepatitis B Vaccine; 11 (1)\$928,000 for Varicella Vaccine; 12 (2)\$3,600,000 for Rotavirus Vaccine; and 13 (3) \$780,000 for outreach and follow-up activities. 14 (4) 15 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
