EFFECTIVE DATE: When Bill becomes law

BILL SUMMARY: Amends GS 143-16.1 to provide that no federal grant concerning the subject areas of social services, health, or elementary or secondary education may be accepted or expended without the approval of the General Assembly, except those relating to unanticipated disasters such as floods, hurricanes, or tornadoes, or research grants within the University of North Carolina or the community college system. If the General Assembly is not in session, and the governor determines that prompt action is required with respect to a grant, the Governor may call an extra session of the General Assembly. Establishes the Federal Funds Oversight Committee within the legislative branch and provides that no federal grant may be applied for, accepted, or expended by the state unless a report of the proposal is transmitted to the committee before the application is made. Committee consists of three members of the House appointed by the Speaker and one appointed by the Minority Leader; three members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore and one by the minority leader; and one member appointed by the Governor.

- 1. The Commission will meet quarterly as required; differences in annual costs between years are based upon the assumed number of meetings in that year (e.g., odd-numbered years: 4 meetings; even-numbered, 3 meetings) to adjust for beginning of legislative sessions..
- 2. Each meeting will comprise 2 full days.
- 3. There will be 100% attendance among members
- 4. Estimates are based upon standard cost estimates and categories used by the General Assembly Research Division estimates for study commissions.
