BILL SUMMARY:

TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HIGH POINT TO USE PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGES AS PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF A TRAFFIC VIOLATION. Adds the City of High Point to a local act for the City of Charlotte (S.L. 1997-216) to provide authorization as title indicates. Source: Institute of Government, Daily Bulletin, March 15, 1999.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

City of High Point

High Point would be authorized to use the same red light technology as Charlotte to provide prima facie evidence of a traffic violation. The bill does not provide funds or require anything from the state except approval. Further, bill does not mandate but **authorizes** City of High Point to use photographic images, etc., as evidence of a violation.
