City of Greenville

Greenville would be authorized to use the same red light technology as Charlotte to provide prima facie evidence of a traffic violation. The bill does not provide funds or require anything from the state except approval. Further, bill does not mandate but **authorizes** City of Greenville to use photographic images, etc., as evidence of a violation.
