**PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT(S) & PROGRAM(S) AFFECTED**: Judicial Department, Guardian ad Litem Program

**EFFECTIVE DATE**: When it becomes law.

**BILL SUMMARY**: This act would provide that an attorney be present at step of the proceeding when a non attorney is appointed as a guardian ad litem in a case rather than just through the dispositional phase of the case.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

The Fiscal Research Division believes this legislation would have a moderate fiscal impact on Guardian ad Litem (GAL) attorney expenditures. In FY 1997-98 approximately 2,146 of 22,378 total proceedings (9.6%) occurred without an attorney present. This bill would require that an attorney be present at all of these proceedings in order to assist non-attorney GAL volunteers. Currently, the GAL Program spends about \$1,000,000 each year to provide representation for these proceedings. Thus, it is estimated that these other proceedings that didn't have attorneys present previously, would require an additional \$100,000 in attorney expenses each year, if the legislation is enacted. It is anticipated that the additional \$400,000 in recurring funds appropriated in the 1999 budget for GAL attorneys would be sufficient to cover these additional expense
