Assault inflicting serious injury on a law enforcement, probation, or 8 parole officer or on a person employed at a State or local detention 9 facility." 10 **SECTION 2.** Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: 11 "§ 14-34.9. Assault on a law enforcement officer. 12 Unless covered under some other provision of law providing greater punishment, a 13 person is guilty of a Class I felony if the person assaults a law enforcement officer while 14 the officer is discharging or attempting to discharge his or her official duties." 15
