6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the
8	procedures regarding the certification of acknowledgments by register of deeds,
9	pursuant to G.S. 47-14, for instruments to be recorded in the office of the register of
10	deeds.
11	In conducting its study, the Legislative Research Commission shall address
12	the following issues, in addition to any others it deems appropriate:
13	(1) Whether G.S. 47-14 continues to serve a useful purpose in the
14	recording of real property instruments.
15	(2) Whether the requirements of G.S. 47-14 should be modified in light of
16	the large volume of recordings in many counties.

- the large volume of recordings in many counties.
- Whether modifications to G.S. 47-14 are necessary to facilitate the (3) electronic recording of real property instruments.

SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the 2003 General Assembly.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
