(a) Any male United States citizen or immigrant who is at least 18	years of age
but less than 26 years of age shall be registered in compliance with the re	
the Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C. § 453 (1948), when app

(b) The Division shall forward in an electronic format the neces	sary personal
information of the applicants identified in subsection (a) of this section	
registration to the Selective Service System. An application for the issuance

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
