2	AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE COMPREHENSIVE INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE
3	ON MOTOR VEHICLE WINDSHIELD GLASS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 58-36-65 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
6	"(n) The subclassification plan shall provide that the comprehensive coverage
7	deductible shall not apply to motor vehicle glass. The deductible provisions of any
8	policy of motor vehicle insurance for either comprehensive property damage or any
9	combined additional insurance delivered or issued in this State by an insurer authorized
10	to write motor vehicle insurance in this State shall not be applicable to damage to the
11	windshield of any motor vehicle covered under that policy."
12	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
