5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration

9	(40a) Special Forces Association. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
10	motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a
11	representation of the U.S. Army Special Forces shoulder patch with
12	tabs and shall bear the words "U.S. Army Special Forces."
13	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:
14	"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
15	registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled

registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

Distribution of Fees. - The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(b17) Special Forces Association. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a Special Forces Association plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Special Forces Association plates to the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division Association, Incorporated to be used to support the Airborne & Special Operations Museum in Fayetteville, North Carolina."

**SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
