Short Title: No Decrease in FTE Funds/UNC System. (Public) Representatives Miller; Bell, Hunter, Lucas, Luebke, Michaux, Oldham, Sponsors: Wainwright, and Womble. Referred to: Appropriations. April 26, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NO CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE 3 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SHALL RECEIVE LESS IN STATE FUNDING FOR THE ENROLLMENT OF FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT STUDENTS THAN WAS RECEIVED BY THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION FOR THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 116-40.7. No decrease in FTE funding for constituent institutions. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each constituent institution shall receive an allocation of State funds each fiscal year for full-time student enrollment that equals or is greater than the State funds allocated to the institution for full-time student 14 enrollment in the preceding fiscal year."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
