## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE GRANVILLE HOSPITAL TO USE ATTACHMENT 2 AND GARNISHMENT PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTING UNPAID BILLS. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Whenever hospital services are provided by Granville Hospital 5 and a recipient of these services fails to pay the charges fixed for the services for a 6 period of 120 days after demand is made for the rendering of the services, the hospital 7 may treat the amount due for the services as if it were a tax due to the County of 8 Granville and may attach wages or other compensation, rents, bank deposits, or any 9 10 other intangible property and may proceed to collect the amount due through the use of the attachment and garnishment proceedings provided in G.S. 105-364 and G.S. 11 105-368. 12 13 **SECTION 2.** This act is supplemental to any provisions provided under 14 general law. **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 15
