ATTACHMENT AND GARNISHMENT PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTING
UNPAID BILLS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Whenever hospital services are provided by Granville Medical
Center and a recipient of these services fails to pay the charges fixed for the services for
a period of 120 days after demand is made for the rendering of the services, the medical
center may treat the amount due for the services as if it were a tax due to the County of
Granville and may attach wages or other compensation, rents, bank deposits, or an
other intangible property and may proceed to collect the amount due through the use of
the attachment and garnishment proceedings provided in G.S. 105-364 and G.S.
105-368.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is supplemental to any provisions provided under
general law.
<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
