STUDY COMMISSION CONTRACTS FOR ISSUANCE OF MOTOR VEHICLE
REGISTRATION PLATES AND CERTIFICATES TO INCREASE THE RATE
PAID PER TRANSACTION TO COMMISSION CONTRACT AGENTS FOR
THE ISSUANCE OF PLATES AND CERTIFICATES.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(h) reads as rewritten:

9 Commission Contracts for Issuance of Plates and Certificates. - All "(h) registration plates, registration certificates and certificates of title issued by the 10 Division, outside of those issued from the Raleigh offices of the said Division and those 11 issued and handled through the United States mail, shall be issued insofar as practicable 12 and possible through commission contracts entered into by the Division for the issuance 13 of such plates and certificates in localities throughout North Carolina with persons, 14 firms, corporations or governmental subdivisions of the State of North Carolina and the 15 Division shall make a reasonable effort in every locality, except as hereinbefore noted, 16 to enter into a commission contract for the issuance of such plates and certificates and a 17 18 record of these efforts shall be maintained in the Division. In the event the Division is 19 unsuccessful in making commission contracts as hereinbefore set out it shall then issue 20 said plates and certificates through the regular employees of the Division. Whenever registration plates, registration certificates and certificates of title are issued by the 21 Division through commission contract arrangements, the Division shall provide proper 22 supervision of such distribution. Commission contracts entered under this subsection 23 24 shall provide for the payment of compensation for all transactions as set forth below. 25 Nothing contained in this subsection will allow or permit the operation of fewer outlets in any county in this State than are now being operated. 26 A transaction is any of the following activities: 27
