1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A NORTH CAROLINA
3	COMMUNITY COLLEGES INSTRUCTIONAL TRUST FUND.
4	Whereas, the General Statutes provide for the establishment of private,
5	nonprofit corporations to support the community colleges system; and
6	Whereas, the General Statutes also permit the trustees of each community
7	college "to receive and accept donations, gifts, bequests, and the like from private
8	donors and to apply them or invest any of them and apply the proceeds for purposes and
9	upon the terms which the donor may prescribe and which are consistent with the
10	provisions of this Chapter and the regulations of the State Board of Community
11	Colleges"; and
12	Whereas, through these enabling statutes, the community colleges have raised
13	millions of dollars to provide scholarships and other forms of student financial aid,
14	capital improvement funds, and multiple other enhancements to the missions of the
15	community colleges; and
16	Whereas, these funds supplement State appropriations for grants-in-aid to the
17	local colleges; Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended
20	by adding a new section to read:
21	" <u>§ 115D-42. North Carolina Community Colleges Instructional Trust Fund.</u>
22	(a) <u>There is established the North Carolina Community Colleges Instructional</u>
23	Trust Fund. The purpose of this Trust Fund is to supplement the funds raised by
24	community college foundations to enhance the academic missions of community
25	<u>colleges.</u>
26	(b) <u>State funds from the Trust Fund and matching funds raised by foundations</u>
27	shall be used by the board of trustees of a community college only to enhance the

3	<u>(1)</u>	Resource center materials;
