| 6 | SECTION 1. G.S. 62A-8 reads as rewritten: |
| 7 | "§ 62A-8. Payments from Fund. |
| 8 | (a) Money from the Emergency Telephone System Fund shall be used only to |
| 9 | pay for: for all costs associated with operating a 911 system, including any of the |
| 10 | following: |
| 11 | (1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone |
| 12 | equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software and |
| 13 | database provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of |
| 14 | establishing a 911 system, and system. |
| 15 | (2) The rates associated with the service supplier's 911 service and other |
| 16 | service supplier recurring charges. |
| 17 | (b) The following expenses are not eligible for payment from the Fund: |
| 18 | $(3) \qquad \text{the The lease or purchase of real estate, estate.}$ |
| 19 | (4) cosmetic <u>The cosmetic</u> remodeling of emergency dispatch |
| 20 | centers, centers. |
| 21 | (5) <u>hiring, Hiring,</u> training, and compensating <u>dispatchers, and dispatchers.</u> |
| 22 | (6) the <u>The</u> purchase of mobile communications vehicles, ambulances, fire |
| 23 | engines, or other emergency vehicles. |
| 24 | (c) A local government may contract with a service supplier for any term |
| 25 | negotiated by the service supplier and the local government and may make payments |
| 26 | from the Emergency Telephone System Fund to provide any payments required by the |
| 27 | contract." |
| 28 | SECTION 2. This act applies to Washington County only. |

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SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
