April 4, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO RESTRICT THE AUTHORITY OF A SOCIAL WORKER TO ENTER A PRIVATE RESIDENCE FOR INVESTIGATION PURPOSES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 7B-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: A social services worker may not enter a private residence for investigation purposes without at least one of the following: The permission of the head of the household. (1) The accompaniment of a law enforcement officer who has legal (2) authority to enter the residence." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
