1 "(c) When it is necessary for the Department of Transportation to acquire a right-2 of-way in order to pave a secondary road or undertake a maintenance project, the Department shall negotiate the acquisition of the right-of-way for a period of up to six 3 months. At the end of that period, if one or more property owners have not dedicated the 4 5 necessary right-of-way and at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the property owners adjacent to the project and the owners of seventy-five percent (75%) of the road 6 7 frontage adjacent to the project have dedicated the necessary property for the right-of-8 way and have provided funds required by Department rule to the Department to cover 9 the costs of condemning the remaining property, the Department shall initiate condemnation proceedings pursuant to Article 9 of this Chapter to acquire the remaining 10 11 property necessary for the project." 12
