The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the				
Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)				
for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)				
for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to fund the activities of the North Carolina Geographic				
Alliance, which is headquartered at East Carolina University. These funds shall be used by the Alliance to:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to establish a North Carolina geography education endowment. The proceeds from the endowment shall be used to fund the activities of the North Carolina Geographic Alliance, which are set out in Section 1 of this act. These funds shall be matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every two dollars (\$2.00) of State funds.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
