A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of four million seven hundred forty thousand dollars (\$4,740,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Council for Women for the continuation of domestic violence programs within the State. Of these funds, the North Carolina Council for Women shall allocate sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) each year of the biennium to each of the 77 existing domestic violence programs and to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Inc.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
