2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE A YEARLONG	
3	COURSE OF INSTRUCTION ON NORTH CAROLINA HISTORY AND	
4	GEOGRAPHY TO ALL FOURTH- AND EIGHTH-GRADE STUDENTS.	
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-81 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
7	"(b1) Both the standard course of study and the Basic Education Program shall	
8	include the requirement that the public schools provide a yearlong course of instruction	
9	on North Carolina history and geography to all students in the fourth grade and all	
10	students in the eighth grade. The course at each grade level shall include at least four	
11	weeks of instruction relating to the local area in which the students reside."	
12	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all	
13	school years beginning with the 2001-2002 school year.
