6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of G.S. 160A-300.1 reads as rewritten:
8	"(d) This act-section applies to the Cities of Charlotte, Fayetteville, Greensboro,
9	High Point, Rocky Mount, Wilmington, Greenville, and Lumberton, and the Towns of
10	Chapel Hill, Cornelius, Huntersville, Marshville, Matthews, and Pineville Pineville, and
11	<u>Stallings</u> only."
12	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
