A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CONCORD IN CABARRUS COUNTY  
3 AND THE CITY OF MONROE AND THE TOWNS OF MARSHVILLE AND  
4 STALLINGS IN UNION COUNTY TO USE PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGES AS  
5 PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF A TRAFFIC VIOLATION AND TO PREVENT  
6 INSURANCE POINTS FROM BEING ASSESSED.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** Subsection (d) of G.S. 160A-300.1 reads as rewritten:

9 "(d) This ~~aet-section~~ applies to the Cities of Concord, Charlotte, Fayetteville,  
10 Greensboro, High Point, Monroe, Rocky Mount, Wilmington, Greenville, and  
11 Lumberton, and the Towns of Chapel Hill, Cornelius, Huntersville, Marshville,  
12 Matthews, ~~and Pineville-Pineville, and Stallings~~ only."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
