9	Fayetteville, Greensboro, High Point, Monroe, Raleigh, Rocky Mount, Wilmington,
10	Greenville, and Lumberton, and to the Towns of Cary, Chapel Hill, Cornelius,
11	Huntersville, Marshville, Matthews, Mineral Springs, and Pineville Pineville, and
12	Stallings only."
13	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
