A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO ADOPT ORDINANCES REGARDING THE NUMBER OF TOILETS TO BE PLACED IN CERTAIN BUILDINGS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any provision of the State Building Code or 6 any public or local law to the contrary, including Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, 7 counties may establish by ordinance the requirements for bathroom facilities, including 8 the number of toilets required, in buildings that are used primarily for school sporting 9 events.

10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law, and only applies to 11 counties that (i) have a population of 190,000 or more according to the most recent 12 decennial federal census and (ii) border both another state and a county with a 13 population of 650,000 or more according to the most recent decennial federal census.
