1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO FURTHER RESTRICT THE HOUR THAT A TELEPHONE  
3 SOLICITOR MAY INITIATE A CALL TO A RESIDENTIAL TELEPHONE  
4 SUBSCRIBER.  
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
6 SECTION 1. G.S. 75-30.1(e) reads as rewritten:  
7 "(e) No telephone solicitor shall initiate a call to a residential telephone subscriber  
8 after ~~9:00 P.M.~~6:00 P.M. or before 8:00 A.M. at the called party's location."  
9 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
