2 AN ACT ALLOWING THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO
3 CHARGE AN ADMISSION FEE TO ANY MUSEUM, HISTORIC PROPERTY,
4 OR OTHER LOCATION OR EVENT ADMINISTERED BY THE
5 DEPARTMENT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended
8 by adding a new section to read:

9 **"§ 143B-53.1. Admission fees.**

10 In addition to powers granted pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 121 of the General
11 Statutes or any other general law, the Department of Cultural Resources may charge an
12 admission fee to any museum, historic property, or other location or event administered
13 by the Department. Admission fees collected under this section are receipts of the
14 Department and shall be deposited in a nonreverting account. The Department shall
15 retain unbudgeted receipts at the end of each fiscal year, beginning June 30, 2001, and
16 shall deposit these receipts into the account. Funds in the account shall be used for
17 maintenance, repairs, renovations, and any other purpose deemed necessary by the
18 Secretary of Cultural Resources. The Secretary may adopt rules necessary to carry out
19 the provisions of this section. The Department shall provide an annual report on the use
20 of fees collected pursuant to this section to the Office of State Budget, Planning, and
21 Management and to the Fiscal Research Division of the Legislative Services Office."

22 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective June 30, 2001.
