board shall give notice to the student's parent or guardian of the student	ent's rights under
this section. If English is the second language of the parent or guardian	n, the notice shall
be written in the parent or guardian's first language when the app	propriate foreign
language resources are readily available and in English, and both ver	rsions shall be in
plain language and shall be easily understandable."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.	, and applies to
disciplinary actions initiated on or after that date.
