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Short Title: Care for School Children With Diabetes Act. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: April 5, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT AND DISSEMINATE GUIDELINES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT **AND** IMPLEMENTATION OF INDIVIDUAL DIABETES CARE PLANS AND TO REQUIRE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT THESE GUIDELINES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(31) To Adopt Guidelines for Individual Diabetes Care Plans. – The State Board shall adopt guidelines for the development and implementation of individual diabetes care plans. The State Board shall consult with the North Carolina Diabetes Advisory Council established by the Department of Health and Human Services in the development of these guidelines. The State Board also shall consult with local school administrative unit employees who have been designated as responsible for coordinating their individual unit's efforts to comply with federal regulations adopted under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 794. In its development of these guidelines, the State Board shall refer to the guidelines recommended by the American Diabetes Association for the management of children with diabetes in the school and day care setting and shall consider recent resolutions by the United States Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights of investigations into complaints alleging discrimination against students with diabetes. The guidelines adopted by the State Board shall include: Procedures for the development of an individual diabetes care plan at the written request of the student's parent or guardian, and involving the parent or guardian, the student's health care provider, the student's classroom teacher, the student if

1		appropriate, the school nurse if available, and other appropriate
2		school personnel.

5		responsibilities and appropriate staff development for teachers

14		the American Diabetes Association's recommendations for the

40	SECTION	4. This act is effective when it becomes law. The guidelines

under Section 1 of this act shall be adopted no later than January 15, 2003, and shall be

implemented under Section 2 of this act beginning with the 2003-2004 school year.

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
