4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Section 7.7.(c) of S.L. 2000-67 is rewritten to read:
6	"Section 7.7.(c) Effective July 1, 2002, G.S. 143-15.3B(a), as rewritten by
7	subsection (b) of this section, reads as rewritten:
8	'(a) The Clean Water Management Trust Fund is established in G.S. 113-145.3.
9	The General Assembly finds that, due to the critical need in this State to clean up
10	pollution in the State's surface waters and to protect and conserve those waters that are
11	not yet polluted, it is imperative that the State provide a minimum of forty million
12	dollars (\$40,000,000) seventy million dollars (\$70,000,000) each calendar year to the
13	Clean Water Management Trust Fund; therefore, there is annually appropriated from the
14	General Fund to the Clean Water Management Trust Fund the sum of forty million
15	dollars (\$40,000,000). seventy million dollars (\$70,000,000).' "
16	SECTION 2. Section 7.7.(d) of S.L. 2000-67 is rewritten to read:
17	"Section 7.7.(d) Effective July 1, 2003, G.S. 143-15.3B(a), as rewritten by
18	subsections (b) and (c) of this section, reads as rewritten:
19	'(a) The Clean Water Management Trust Fund is established in G.S. 113-145.3.
20	The General Assembly finds that, due to the critical need in this State to clean up
21	pollution in the State's surface waters and to protect and conserve those waters that are
22	not yet polluted, it is imperative that the State provide a minimum of seventy million
23	dollars (\$70,000,000) one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) each calendar year to
24	the Clean Water Management Trust Fund; therefore, there is annually appropriated from
25	the General Fund to the Clean Water Management Trust Fund the sum of seventy
26	million dollars (\$70,000,000). one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000).' "
27	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
