A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT LIMITING THE QUANTITY OF MOTOR FUEL SOLD OR
OFFERED FOR SALE UNDER THE MOTOR FUEL MARKETING ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 75-88 reads as rewritten:

"§ 75-88. **Public disclosure; disclosure; quantity of motor fuel available for sale.**

(a) Any refiner or terminal supplier computing prevailing price under the provisions of G.S. 75-81(4)(a)(i) or (ii) shall be required to publicly disclose ~~said~~ this price.

(b) No person shall limit the quantity of motor fuel sold or offered for sale from a motor fuel pump to any one customer to a quantity less than the entire supply that is owned or possessed by the seller and that the seller is authorized to sell at the place of the sale or offering for sale.

(c) Motor fuel that is purchased under subsection (b) of this section shall be subject to Article 2 and Article 3 of Chapter 119 of the General Statutes and enforced by the Commissioner of Agriculture.

(d) Any violation under this section is punishable as a Class 2 misdemeanor."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to sales and offers of sale on or after that date.
