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A HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SPEAKERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO APPOINT A BLUE RIBBON TASK FORCE TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO MEDICAL MALPRACTICE.

Whereas, the issues surrounding medical malpractice and the remedies proposed to address these issues are very complex, affecting both health care practice and health care access; and

Whereas, the issues surrounding medical malpractice are of extreme importance to all citizens of North Carolina; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

SECTION 1. The Speakers of the House of Representatives may appoint a Blue Ribbon Task Force on Medical Malpractice to conduct a comprehensive study of the following:

- (1) The complex causes of and remedies for medical malpractice.
- (2) Rapidly escalating professional liability premiums for health care providers.
- (3) The impact of medical malpractice issues on health care accessibility in North Carolina.
- (4) Other matters related to medical malpractice and its impact on health care access.

SECTION 2. The Speakers of the House of Representatives shall appoint 26 members to the Blue Ribbon Task Force composed of members of the House of Representatives and a balanced representation of the insurance industry, health care consumers, medical providers, trial lawyers, and related interest groups.

SECTION 3. The Blue Ribbon Task Force on Medical Malpractice shall make recommendations to the 2004 Regular Session of the 2003 General Assembly upon its reconvening.

SECTION 4. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
