Short Title: Increase Civil Penalty for Workplace Death. (Public) **Sponsors:** Representative Goodwin. Referred to: Occupational Safety and Health. April 10, 2003 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AMENDING THE LABOR LAWS OF NORTH CAROLINA TO INCREASE THE RANGE OF CIVIL PENALTIES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED WHEN A WORKPLACE DEATH OCCURS DUE TO EMPLOYER NEGLIGENCE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 95-138 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(a1) Any employer whose actual negligence, or whose continued maintenance of an unsafe condition, results in a workplace death may upon the recommendation of the Director to the Commissioner be assessed by the Commissioner a civil penalty of not more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) and not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000)."
