SESSION LAW 2004-87 HOUSE BILL 1649

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE WAKE COUNTY TO REGULATE THE USE OF IMPAIRING SUBSTANCES WHILE HUNTING WITH FIREARMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. A county may regulate, control, restrict, and prohibit hunting with firearms by persons under the influence of an impairing substance. For the purposes of this act, an impairing substance is defined as set forth in G.S. 20-4.01. **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Wake County. **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 9th day of July, 2004.
