SESSION LAW 2004-62 **HOUSE BILL 1659**

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGULATING THE USE OF HUNTING STANDS IN PERQUIMANS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of S.L. 2001-330 reads as rewritten: "**SECTION 2.** It is unlawful to hunt with a center-fired rifle except from a stand at least eight five feet above ground level." SECTION 2. This act applies only to Perquimans County. SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2004.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 7th day of July, 2004.
