SECTION 1. G.S. 14-277.3(b) reads as rewritten:	
"(b) Classification A violation of this section is a Class A1 misdem	eanor. A
person convicted of a Class A1 misdemeanor under this section, who is senten	nced to a
community punishment, shall be placed on supervised probation in addition to	any other
punishment imposed by the court. A person who commits the offense of stalks	ing when
there is a court order in effect prohibiting similar behavior by that person is g	uilty of a
Class H felony. A person who commits the offense of stalking after have	ing been
previously convicted of a stalking offense is guilty of a Class F felony."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and a	applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
