HOUSE BILL 338

Short Title: Greensboro Vehicle Tax. (Local)

Sponsors: Representatives Adams and Jones (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to: Finance.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREENSBORO TO COLLECT A TAX
ON MOTOR VEHICLES RESIDENT IN THE CITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not more than ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ thirty dollars (\$30.00) per year upon any vehicle resident in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax may be used for any lawful purpose."

SECTION 2. Chapter 31 of the 1991 Session Laws is repealed.

SECTION 3. This act applies to the City of Greensboro only.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
